Task 2: Trust & Identity Incubator (T&II)



The GN4-3 WP5 T2 Trust and Identity Incubator ("T&I Incubator") aims to develop, foster and mature new ideas in the Trust and Identity space in Research and Education.

The incubator will investigate new technologies that currently **have no place yet** in the services ecosystem of the GEANT project. It will test and experiment with potential new features for existing services.

In addition also **business case development** for potential new services and developments that would **improve data protection and privacy aspects** in services or software are in scope.



T&II Activity Methodology & Team



Methodology

- Agile, using Scrum like approach
- 4-6 **activities** in parallel
- 6 month cycles, 1 month sprints
- Sprint demo for all activities at same time

Activity Team (the A-Team!)

- 1 or 2 'Principle Investigators'(PI) who own the problem
- Scrum master who supports processes (Jule or Michael)
- Support from T&II team as needed, e.g. technical or business development
- Mentor







T&II A-Team Responsibilities




- Plan sprints w/ Scrum Master
- Give realistic estimate of availability for next sprint/month
- Take responsibility for your activity cards
- Collaborate with your team!
- Participate in weekly standup
- One team representative to deliver sprint demo
- Participate in reporting as part of sprint review



T&II Activity lifecycle



- Activity selected into Incubator either through MIB or based on proposal from 2 NRENs
- PIs and TL set goals for Activity
- Run Activity
 - Activity kick-off
 - 6x Sprints and Demos
- Activities get reviewed by Advisory Board
- Based on review, an activity may be:
 - Moved to Service Activity;
 - Terminated;
 - Continued with a new focus;
- Team setup may be changed, based on requirements
- PIs will likely change with new activities





T&II Main Incubator Board (MIBs)



- Senior members of our community
- Several also act as mentors in the A-Teams
- Advise TL on current and new activities
- After 6 months, activities get reviewed by MIB, based on final sprint demo and a report
- Board may suggest new topics for the Incubator
- MIB meeting will be set up shortly
