 - MoD, MuS, e-portfolio, Moodle2Test, Moodle2Demo...












E-learning system Merlin (Moodle with custom addins)






Webinar system (Adobe Connect with 52 Named Host licences)








Server architecture

- Huge increase in system resources (CPU, RAM, disk space...)
- Added new server for NFS and Redis (previously running on DB server)
- Fine tuning of all vital services (HaProxy, PHP-FPM, Apache, PostgreSQL...)

Tuning of application source codes












User support (email, phone, consultations...)
