Limited application window	Suppliers can join at anytime
Number of suppliers fixed	Unlimited suppliers may join
Pricing set at outset?	Pricing at contract award stage

- Minimum standards
- Specify own requirements









Suppliers


- Single prequalifying
- Own timescales

Join as a supplier

- Submit an EOI
- Complete a 'RtP'
- No time limit
- ~ 14 day turnaround
