

IRIS Background

eInfrastructure for Research and Innovation for STFC

- Collaboration of Science Activities and Provider Entities
 - Driven by the physics communities supported by UKRI-STFC
- Does not run infrastructure directly
 - Commissions deployment of resources available to all of its science activities





Updates since last meeting

| Date | IRIS Delivery Board approval | Notes |
|---------------|--|--|
| November 2020 | Infrastructure Security Policy | Primary feedback to address IRIS Services that use IRIS IAM IdP and those that don't |
| March 2021 | Revised IRIS AUP and IRIS IAM Privacy Notice working versions were previously in place for IRIS IAM | Feedback primarily around making the policy more specific; the response to keep the policy more open to allow development based on experience was accepted |
| May 2021 | Service Operations Security Policy | Widest set of feedback from services and others Beginning to gather ideas for future Infrastructure Policy development |

 We offer the IRIS Service Operations Security Policy to the WISE SCI-WG for consideration as a new baseline template

Current and future work

- IRIS Risk Assessment
 - Start with IRIS IAM as exemplar
 - Exploring models
 - RAW WG spreadsheets
 - OSCRP asset profiles
 - Cost-based risk assessment
- Current approach
 - Use OSCRP profiles to generate concerns and consequences
 - Use this to inform the use of the RAW WG spreadsheets
 - Noting the benefit of using the quantitative output of the spreadsheets to inform further decision making





Current and future work

- Policies (planned to be) in draft
 - Acceptable Authentication Policy
 - Community Management Policy

- IRIS Security Maturity report
 - SCIv2 Framework assessment
 - IRIS Security Roadmap generated from gap analysis





Observations

- Approval of policies has benefited from establishing a cadence of feedback and approval by IRIS Delivery Board (with feedback more broadly)
- Assurance is a key area of interest
 - Particularly in the context of use of IRIS IAM identity proxy as IdP-of-last-resort
 - Both acceptable assurance profiles and the technical means of expressing assurance by IAM
 - As before, this process is informing discussions on the internal structure of IRIS
