CSIT2021

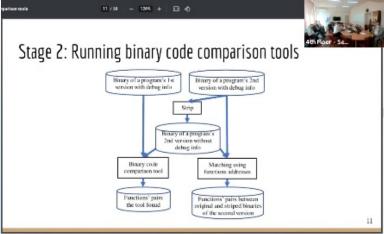
- Being held since 1997, once in two years

Pros and Cons of Hybrid

- More flexible
- Wider audience
- Accessible for people who can't attend
- Having recordings stored to refer back and work with it for analysis, evaluation of the event

- More expensive
- Needs double efforts to harmonize online and onsite audiences
- Technical and technological more support both from technical staff and equipment
 - Mics and cameras both for speakers and audience
 - Room lightening to have a good quality of video for online participants
- Less involvement for online participants
