#### WISE - what is it?

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- Wise Information Security for Collaborating E-infrastructure
- A trusted global framework where security experts can share information on different topics like risk management, experiences about certification process and threat intelligence keeping a special focus on e-infrastructures
- Building trust between Infrastructures and their management
- But not an operational security/trust body
  - Not competing with other activities such as TF-CSIRT, FIRST, trust groups, ...

## How everything started

• Joint effort of <u>GEANT SIG-ISM</u> (Special Interest Group on Information Security Management) and <u>SCI</u> (Security for Collaboration among Infrastructures)

• Workshop in Barcelona Spain, October 2015

• 50 participants

 Main idea: 4 big e-infrastructures EGI, EUDAT, GEANT and PRACE getting together to facilitate the exchange of experience and knowledge on security

• But also NRENs, XSEDE, NCSA, CTSC and communities like HEP/CERN, HBP and many others participated

- Led by a Steering Committee
- At least two face-to-face meetings a year
  - 1st WISE Workshop, Barcelona, 20-22 October 2015
  - BoF session at TNC16, Prague, 14 June 2016
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> WISE Workshop, XSEDE16, Miami, 18 July 2016
- The main work happens through working groups
- Five WGs were created:
  - Updating the SCI framework (SCIV2-WG)
  - Security Training and Awareness (STAA-WG)
  - Security Review and Audit (SRA-WG)
  - Risk Assessment WISE (RAW-WG)
- WISE@DI4R Security in Big and Open Data (SBOD-WG)

### Future plans?

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- Alessandra Scicchitano is leaving GEANT
  - Hannah Short (CERN) will replace her as WISE Coordinator
- At end of year one time to review
- Are the working groups making progress?
  - Can we organise differently?
- Are there other topics we should address?
  - Cloud Security

  - In 2017 we will probably move to standalone meetings (Europe and USA)
