


eduroam Visitor Access

- Allow guests to use eduroam
 - Eliminate needs of other Wi-Fi networks
 - Allows roaming on Campus / shared buildings (if allowed by NRO)
 - Delegate creation of guests to employees
- Platform to allow normal users to create guests
 - Bulk options
- Scratch cards
- Events
- Self provisioning options
 - Kiosk via API function
 - Narrowcast screens (SMS)


- Create guests

- Create SMS-event






Advanced user

- Superuser manages organizations





Regular institution admin.



Profiles


 Profiles determine what users are allowed to do








Add/edit organizations





eVA's footprint

- eVA is used by almost 100 institutions in NL, and deployed in (at least)
 - CA
 - NZ
 - UK
 - ZA
- Pilots in
 - CH
 - FI
 - IE
 - UG
- Rebranded for govroam outside of eduroam
- SURF can host for a charge, but you can get access to the repo and run it yourself

A simple/demo setup is trivial

- Clone the repo
- Run docker-compose up -d in support/provisioning/docker-compose

Some challenges remain

- Development capacity
 - Running in Sprints
 - Will have better maintenance contract soon
- Stable service, most new features are requested from outside NL
