Here are the instructions for joining the video conference.

The conference is hosted on the NIIF MCU in Budapest, and there are several ways of connecting to it.

- **The easiest option is to connect to the MCU directly at its IP address 193.225.95.130. Once connected, enter 9984# as the conference ID, then enter 8741# as the conference security PIN.**
- If your equipment is able to use Global Dialing Scheme (GDS) numbers, you can dial 003655119984, then enter 8741# as the conference security PIN.
- You can also connect by phone: dial the (Hungarian) phone number +36-1-666-1112. Once connected, dial 9984# for the conference ID, then enter 8741# as the conference security PIN.
