

Request Client Certificates

- The Client Certificates tab contains three types of certificates:
- [blocked URL](#)
- **Premium** Certificates are almost always the best choice. A premium certificate is useful for personal
 - Client Authentication
 - Document Signing
 - Email Encryption
 - Email Signing
- Don't use the **Digital Signature Plus** certificate; it is just a limited variant of Premium.
- **Email Security Plus** offers the possibility to have your private key stored by DigiCert (escrow).
- Both Premium Client Certificates and Document Signing Certificates can be used to sign documents. Certainly in an Adobe Acrobat environment there is a preference for [Document Signing certificates](#).
